



Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2007

This year we have had several examples of long-lived birds (as well as showing site fidelity). A Willow Warbler retrapped this year was previously ringed as a juvenile in 2000. Birds ringed in 2001 and retrapped this year were two Blackbirds, both males (with one being an adult in at least its third calendar year at the time of ringing), two Long-tailed Tits, two Great Tits and an adult male Chaffinch.
