



Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2013

Noteworthy records-

- Great Tit (TE89027) was ringed as a pullus on 28th May 2005. The bird was not recaptured again until a CES session on 26th May 2013. At 7 years 363 days, this is a new longevity record for the species at Stanford Reservoir.
